

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGES TO A WATER RIGHT**  
**DOUGLAS COUNTY WATER CONSERVANCY BOARD**

**TAKE NOTICE:** That on 08/08/2022 Twin W Irrigation District of Douglas Co. Washington filed an application with the Douglas County Water Conservancy Board which was accepted and assigned identifier No. DOUG 22-04. You are encouraged to inquire further as directed below, but be advised of the following details:

Surface water right S4-26143C was issued to Edgewater Orchards Inc. and Northwest Farm Credit with a priority date of 02/20/1979. The subject right authorizes the use of 0.66cfs and 180af for the seasonal irrigation of 45ac. Water is diverted from a location on the Columbia River which occurs within NENW Sec. 12, T26N, R21E for use within portion of SENW and NESW of Section 12, T 26N, R21E lying north and west of highway.

The application requests to increase authorized irrigated acres to reflect changes from orchard to vineyard with drip irrigation, change the place use to include portion of SENW and NESW of Section 12, T 26N, R21E lying north and west of highway; portions of NE Sec. 12, T26N, R21E and NW Sec. 7, T26N, R22E occurring between Highway 97 and Orchard Place and Vineyard Drive; AND Lot 2 Zinfandel SP, TOGETHER WITH TAX 39; AKA PCL B OF BLA 3239574 all in Douglas County, WA; and change and add a point of withdrawal located with SWSW Sec. 6, T26N, R22E.

Any protests or objections to the approval of this application may be filed with the Department of Ecology and must include a detailed statement of the basis for objections; protests must be accompanied by a fifty dollar (\$50) recording fee and filed with the Department of Ecology Cashiering Unit, P.O. Box 47611, Olympia, WA 98504-7611 within thirty (30) days from November 10, 2022.

Any interested party may submit comments, objections, and other information to the Board regarding this application. The comments and information may be submitted in writing or verbally at any public meeting of the Board held to discuss or decide on the application. This application will be on the Boards agenda during its regular meeting to be held on the second Monday of each month at 4:00 p.m. at 104 East Locust Street, Waterville WA until a decision on the application is made. Additionally, the Douglas County Water Conservancy Board may receive written comments or information provided within thirty days from November 10, 2022 at its office, P.O. Box 608, Waterville, WA 98858.
