


This proposition would authorize the district to levy excess taxes upon all taxable property within the district in the sum of \$25,000, requiring collection of approximately \$0.17 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation in 2010. This proposition authorizes the District to acquire new fire fighting equipment, undertake capital improvements to the existing main station and to issue \$350,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 15 years to finance such improvements, and to levy property taxes annually in excess of regular property tax levies to repay such bonds, as provided in Resolution No. 09-01.
