INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

1. USE ONLY A BLACK OR BLUE PEN.
2. VOTE FOR ONLY ONE CHOICE FOR EACH OFFICE OR BALLOT MEASURE, unless the office or ballot measure specifically states otherwise. More than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted.
3. To vote, COMPLETELY FILL IN THE OVAL (●) to the left of your choice.
4. To vote for a candidate not printed on the ballot, COMPLETELY FILL IN THE OVAL (●) to the left of the blank line and write the candidate's name on the blank line.
5. TO CANCEL A VOTE, cross out the candidate name like this

● ~~George Washington~~

You then have the option of making another choice. The instructions on your secrecy envelope may also be used to change your vote to another choice.

READ: Each candidate for partisan office may state a political party that he or she prefers. A candidate's preference does not imply that the candidate is nominated or endorsed by the party, or that the party approves of or associates with that candidate.
