The public meeting will start at 9:00 AM for the purpose of considering the adoption of a new section to Douglas County Code title 18 Zoning titled the Pangborn Industrial Service Area (PISA) which re-titles/re-numbers the General Industrial Zone currently in place within the PISA Urban Growth Area.

The planning commission has recommended approval of the proposal. A Determination of Non-significance has been issued for the proposals in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act. Department of Commerce has completed the 60 day review.

The Board will take action to accept the recommendation, continue the public meeting to another date and time, or reject the recommendation and set a public hearing to consider revisions to the recommendation.
